- Luke begins Acts where he left off with his record of the gospel resurrection and ascension of Jesus
- overview of Acts review last quarters Bible class, broken down into a few lessons
 main points from the book
- this lesson: Jesus' Resurrection: Centerpiece of Acts what's that mean to us today

► Apostles were witnesses of Jesus' resurrection

- Acts 1:22 qualification of apostle, be a witness with us of His resurrection
 - 1 Cor. 15:3-11 apostles, witnesses of Jesus' resurrection, Paul last, "we preach and so you believe"
- apostles proclaimed Jesus' resurrection
 - Acts 2:32 Peter's sermon, proclaimed, God raised Jesus
 - Acts 3:15 as witnesses of His resurrection
 - Acts 4:33 with great power (miracles) testifying to the resurrection Jesus

Jesus' resurrection proves He's God's Son – must obey the Son

- Rom. 1:4 resurrection, declared Jesus to be God's Son
- since Jesus is God's Son, we must hear and obey Him
 - Heb. 1:1-2, 2:1-4 hear God's Son, not neglect salvation, spoken of by Lord
 - 1 Pet. 1:2 (NASB) sanctifying work of the Spirit, obey Jesus Christ and be sprinkled with His blood
 - Heb. 5:9 source of eternal salvation, everyone who obeys Him

Through Jesus' resurrection, God put an end to the agony of death – possible for men to have eternal life (Rom. 6:23)

- Acts 2:24 resurrection of Jesus, put an end to the agony of death

- Acts 2:31 as prophesied in the OT – Peter quotes from Psalms (David)

- Acts 4:2 apostles message: "in" Jesus, the resurrection from the dead

If you are in Jesus, you will resurrect to eternal life! – the proof: Jesus' resurrection
how do we get in Jesus – later point

> Because Jesus resurrected, we can be saved through Him

- Acts 13:32-34 (Paul to Jews, Pisidian Antioch) Jesus resurrection shows that God gives us the blessings of salvation (holy and sure blessings of David) through Jesus

- Eph. 1:18-20 Jesus' resurrection demonstrates the power of God he works upon us, to save us when we obey Jesus

- 1 Pet. 1:20 -21 through Jesus, we are believers in God, who raised Him faith and hope in God.
 - 1 Pet. 1:3 result: born again, living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead
 - 1 Pet. 1:18-19, 22 how: redeemed, blood of Christ, purified souls by obeying the truth
 - 1 Pet. 3:21 when: baptized
- Because God raised Jesus from the dead, we obey Jesus! result: saved

God saves us by uniting us with Christ, His death and resurrection, when we are baptized – God's power Acts 4:2 "in" Jesus, the resurrection from the dead

- Rom. 6:3a enter "into" Jesus when baptized

- Rom. 6:3-4 baptized: into His death, buried with Him into death, as Christ raised from the dead, so we walk in newness of life (power)

- Rom. 6:5-6 united with Him, likeness of His death, old self crucified with Him, no longer slaves to sin
- Rom. 7:4 made to die, joined to Jesus who was raised from the dead 1 Cor. 6:17

- Col. 2:12 buried with Him in baptism, raised up with Him, faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead (power)

- Rom. 8:1, 10-11 no condemnation in Christ, Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in us, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you

- Col. 3:1-5f our responsibility, reward if been raised with Christ
- When you were baptized into Christ, you were united with Him (death, resurrection, raised up).
 As a Christian, you're living up to your responsibilities, you will resurrect to everlasting life.

> Jesus' resurrection proves His name is authoritative – His name is authoritative

- Rom. 1:4; Acts 4:2 Jesus resurrection, proved He's God's Son, resurrected in Him, He has authority from God – name – Matt. 28:18

- Jesus' name: salvation
 - Acts 4:12 salvation in no one (nothing) other than Jesus, no other name, must be saved
 - Acts 2:21 call on His name to be saved
 - Rom. 10:14, 17 must hear word, before can call on Jesus' name
 - Acts 22:16 call on His name by being baptized result: sins washed away
 - 1 Pet. 3:21 appeal, baptism now saves you, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ
 because Jesus resurrected, we can be saved when we obey Him baptized Mk. 16:16
 - 1 Pet. 1:3 God's mercy, causes us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead 1 Pet. 3:21; Jn. 3:5
- Jesus' name: all we do Christians (Acts 9:14)
 - Col. 3:17 everything, name of Jesus authority Matt. 28:18-19
 - Jn. 4:24 worship in spirit and truth
 - Mk. 7:6-9 not vain worship, with traditions of men work and worship of the church
 - 2 Jn. 1:9 else, we do not have God
 - Gal. 1:8-9; 5:4 accursed, severed from Christ, fallen from grace
 - Acts 9:14 people who call on Jesus' name are Christians 1 Cor. 1:2; 2 Tim. 2:22
- Jesus' prayer hours before crucifixion
 - Jn. 17:1-2 glorify your Son, gave Him authority over all flesh, give eternal life
- If you are calling on the name of the Lord in all you do, Jesus will give you eternal life!

► Because Jesus resurrected, we are empowered as disciples

- Rom. 8:33-34 God empowers us through Christ, in part because of His resurrection
- context: empowerment (Rom. 8)
 - Rom. 8:1-2 in Christ, no condemnation, set free from the law of sin and death
 - Rom. 8:10-11 eternal life
 - Rom. 8:14-17 relationship with God as His child
 - Rom. 8:26-27 intercession of the Spirit, communicate the things of our minds to God
 - Rom. 8:28 God works all things together for good, love the Lord good comes out of everything
 - Rom. 8:31, 32, 33-34, 35, 37-39 Christ intercedes, more than conquers

- Phil. 3:10-11 in this way (Rom. 8) we know the power of His resurrection - result: resurrection, eternal life

- Because Jesus resurrected, we can be saved, and empowered as God's children, to live as God commands, and in the end resurrect to eternal life. – next point

> Because Jesus resurrected, we'll have eternal life in heaven

- Acts 4:2 "in" Jesus, the resurrection from the dead
- 1 Cor. 6:14 God not only raised the Lord, but will also raise us, through His power
 - 1 Cor. 15:20-23 Christ raised, then us at His coming
 - 1 Cor. 15:42-44 spiritual body, raised in power Phil. 3:21
 - 1 Cor. 15:55-57 victory over death in Christ
 - 1 Cor. 15:58 motivates us
- 1 Th. 1:10 wait for Jesus, whom God raised, rescues from wrath
 - 1 Th. 4:14-17 coming of Christ
 - 1 Th. 4:18 motivates, comforts us
