Have the faith of a blind man!

► Intro:

- healing of the blind was a sign that Jesus had come and was preaching the gospel
 - John was in prison, sent disciples to Jesus and asked if He was the Expected One
 - Jesus' answer: "Go and report to John what you hear and see: the BLIND RECEIVE SIGHT and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the POOR HAVE THE
 - GOSPEL PREACHED TO THEM" (Matt. 11:4-5, quoting from the OT Scriptures).
- What can we learn about faith from the blind?

► Believe in Jesus and appeal to Him for mercy! – faith of a blind man

- Matt. 9:27-29 two blind men following Jesus, appealed to Jesus for mercy, healed according to their faith
- ► believe:

- that He can do all the things He promised while you are upon the earth, and save you in the end.
- therefore appeal to Him for mercy
 - appeal through obedience to His commands rf Heb. 5:9 source of eternal salvation to those who obey
 - 1 Pet. 3:21 appeal, obedience, baptism Noah, ark, water appeal to God when we obey
 - appeal process court of law, must follow the process as prescribed God's process is baptism
- > Believe / Obey / Respond Immediately / Ask / Glorify God faith of Bartimaeus, a blind man
 - Mk. 10:46-52 Bartimaeus, blind man, Jericho believed in Jesus and appealed for mercy (above)
- > Bartimaeus sought Jesus rather than please crowd: crowd pressured him to be quiet
 - peer pressure: we can overcome the crowd and obey God
 - 1 Cor. 10:13 peer pressure not new, God not allow to be too strong, way of escape
- Rom. 8:28, 37 be confident can overcome
 - 1 Jn. 2:15-17 don't love the world, sin, fitting in through sinful means
 - Col. 3:1-4 stay focused spiritually, stay focused on heaven
- Bartimaeus immediately responded to Jesus' call: threw off cloak (most valuable possession), jumped up, went to Jesus
 - Have you thrown off your cloak?
 - Matt. 16:24-26 deny self, take up cross, lose life, not forfeit soul,
 - Have you jumped up, or are you procrastinating?
- > Bartimaeus knew exactly what he wanted, and asked Jesus
 - prayer: specific, faith, not doubt confident, peaceful
 - Lk. 11:5-10 persistent, keep seeking and asking and knocking
 - Lk. 18:1-5 parable on persistent prayer, vs. 1 pray and not lose heart squeaky wheel
 - Ja. 1:5-8 pray, faith, not doubting God will perform His will in your life, keep His promises
 - Phil. 4:4-7 rejoice, not anxious but pray, peace guard heat and mind relate to above
- ▶ Bartimaeus glorified God let his light shine, causing other people to glorify God
 - Lk. 18:43 faith glorifies God, shine light, causing others people to glorify God
 - evangelism, showing others the way to God, example not afraid to tell your story

> Believe the simple gospel message – reject the doctrines of men! – like a blind man, faith

- Jn. 9:1, 6-11 Jesus made clay with spit and put on man's eyes, man washed, could see – faith!!!!!!!, man confessed openly what Jesus had done

- faith to allow a man to anoint your eyes with clay made of spit, then to wash as He commanded you e.g., baptism
- ▶ Jn. 9:24-34 healed man believed the truth that dumbfounded men who embraced false religious doctrines
 - faith, believe the simple truth that most people reject
 - be one of the few who walk on the narrow road and enter through the small gate that leads to life (Matt. 7:13-14)
 - faith to share the truth with others, without fear of the cost
- ▶ Jn. 9:17, 26-27, 30 Jesus opened his eyes, but the man still had to do something
- ► Summary / Inv.
 - there is only one way to be healed of spiritual blindness today be a faithful Christian
 2 Pet. 1:9 lack qualities (vs. 5-8) blind and shortsighted
- > inv.: be healed of your spiritual blindness today leave with your sight
