► Intro:

- over the years, it's become popular to talk about financial prosperity in religion
 - seems many are doing so to appeal to greed and lust
 - sow a seed doctrine: send a preacher \$ and get-rich-quick
- this lesson: Bible teaching, What is the secret to Financial Prosperity?
 - **joke:** Beth, are you sure you're qualified yes, the way I'm talking about it I'm broke and I have the right attitude
- **What is being "financially prosperous" for Christians?** being faithful Christian having food and clothing
 - Matt. 6:19-21 Christian paradigm: lay up treasure in heave
 - Matt. 6:24 reason that we must view financial prosperity this way serve God, not wealth
 - our god is the one we serve \$, passionate lusts, Satan, Jehovah
- Matt. 6:25, 31-33 financial prosperity, as Christian, is having food and clothing
 - application / attitude:
 - seek first kingdom of heaven be happy with what God blesses you with
 - Why are little kids who are severely disadvantaged, so much happier than most blessed adults?
 - financially prospering as Christian = food and clothing, not lots of \$
 - rf. joke, so I'm qualified
 - attitude / happiness: think feel happy (Gary Steen's class)
 - if faithful Christians and not feel financially prosperous, wrong thinking

► No matter how much God gives us, He wants us to be faithful stewards.

- steward: one put in charge of his master's property, children, or whole household
 - we are steward of God's gifts (Ja. 1:17) \$
- we are stewards of God's grace all the gifts He gives:
 - 1 Pet. 4:9-10 good stewards of God's grace (all the gifts He gives us) therefore be hospitable
- steward: reward and punishment
 - Matt. 25:14-30 parable of the talents today, all the gifts God gives
 - Matt. 25:21 said to faithful slaves
 - Matt. 25:26-30 said to, and about, the unfaithful slave
- judged for our use of God's gifts
 - Matt. 25:34-36 difference between faithful stewards and unfaithful stewards distinguishes saved from lost
- ► God's faithful stewards are generous givers! rf Matt. 25:31-36

- 1 Cor. 16:2 "On the first day of every week each one of you is to put aside and save, as he may prosper, so that no collections be made when I come."

- 2 Cor. 9 2nd epistle, principles of giving
 - 2 Cor. 9:6 principle of sowing and reaping
 - Gal. 6:7 Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap.
- 2 Cor. 9:7 attitude: purposed, not grudgingly or under compulsion, cheerfully
- 2 Cor. 9:8-10 God enriches

- - 1 Cor. 9:11a so we can give liberally
- > 2 Cor. 9:11b-13, 15 result: thanksgiving to God, by receivers
 - illus.: Lk. 21:1-4 poor widow puts two small copper coins into the treasury
 - Do you think God took care of her and blessed her, or let her starve to death? today?

► What's the right attitude toward money (financial prosperity)?

- 1 Pet. 4:9-10 consider whatever you have a blessing from God never despise God's blessings
- 1 Tim. 6:7-10, 17-18 attitude toward money
- **• vs.** 7 can't take \$ with us (eternity), not important in grand scheme
 - vs. 8 be content with food and clothing happy if I have....
- vs. 9 not want to get rich don't care about \$
 - want: to will deliberately, have a purpose, be minded of willing as an affection, to desire
- vs. 10 not love money reason want to get rich (vs. 9) apostasy
- vs. 17 fix your hope on God, not \$ don't trust in \$
 - vs. 18 share, do good, no matter how much you have, store up treasure in heaven

- secret to financial prosperity: lay up treasure in heaven – seek first God's kingdom and His righteousness, be content with food and clothing

- Phil. 4:11-13 learn to be content in whatever state you are, because as a faithful Christian you are financially prospering
- if we have the right attitude about money, we'll use it as good stewards to God's glory, if we don't....
- inv.: 1st step to financial prosperity be faithful Christian
