

The queen of Ahasuerus, and heroine of the **ESTHER** book that bears her name. **22.** The first book of the Bible. **GENESIS** Down 1. A change of mind resulting in a change of **REPENTANCE** action. **3.** A sister of Lazarus. **MARTHA EPHESUS** 4. The capital of proconsular Asia, which was the western part of Asia Minor. It was colonized principally from Athens. In the time of the Romans it bore the title of "the first and greatest metropolis of Asia." It was distinguished for the Temple of Diana (q.v.), who there had her chief shrine; and for its theatre, which was the largest in the world, capable of containing 50,000 spectators. 5. The man killed for touching the ark of the **UZZAH** covenant. **6.** An Arabian patriarch who resided in the land **JOB** of Uz (q.v.). While living in the midst of great prosperity, he was suddenly overwhelmed by a series of sore trials that fell upon him. 7. The king of Salem to whom Abraham paid **MELCHIZEDEK** tithes. **9.** To be persuaded and therefore to place BELIEVE confidence and trust in God. 11. Help. A priest among those that returned to **EZRA** Jerusalem under Zerubabel (Neh. 12:1). 12. An act consisting of the processes of **BAPTIZE** immersion, submersion and emergence in water. 13.
