
Basic Vocabulary Series I: Puzzle 7

- **10.** Abraham's eldest son, by Hagar the concubine (Gen. 16:15; 17:23).
- 12. A descendant of the tribe of Levi.
- **14.** The purchase back of something that had been lost, by the payment of a ransom.

- **3.** A period of time that is endless.
- **4.** One who purchases back something that had been lost, by the payment of a ransom.

- **24.** The book of Scripture divided into the Old Testament and New Testament.
- **25.** An apostle, the brother of James, the son of Zebedee (Matt. 4:21).
- **26.** He was the father of eight sons, the youngest of whom was David (1 Sam. 17:12).

- **16.** A Syrian afflicted with leprosy; and when the little Hebrew slave-girl that waited on his wife told her of a prophet in Samaria (Elisha) who could cure her master.
- **18.** The great deliverance wrought for the children of Isreal when they were brought out of the land of Egypt .
- 20. An Arabian patriarch who resided in the land of Uz (q.v.). While living in the midst of great prosperity, he was suddenly overwhelmed by a series of sore trials that fell upon him.
- 21. This Syriac or Chaldee word is found three times in the New Testament (Mark 14:36; Rom. 8:15; Gal. 4:6), and in each case is followed by its Greek equivalent, which is translated "father."
- **22.** The second of the twelve minor prophets. He was the son of Pethuel.
