Limited Atonement


- Christ died only for the elect

Preservation Of The Saints


Those saved remain saved always








Context of Rom. 9-11 → discussion of how Jew and Gentile fit in God's plan to save lost man cp. 3:23


- Paul's physical brethren are lost 9:3-8
- God cannot be accused of injustice in condemning the Jews 9:14-24
- **3** Jews have zeal, but it is misplaced 10:1-4
- Israel's only hope is to do what the Gentiles do: seek God's election of grace 11:1-6

When Was Abraham's Faith Reckoned?

	Gen 12:4	75 yrs old when he left Haran (Heb 11:8)
-	Gen 15:1-6	Told of numberless seed → <u>believed</u> God
	Gen 16:16	86 yrs old when Ismael was born
- 🗸	Gen 17:1-5 Rom 4:16b-22	99 yrs old when name changed, promised a son by Sarah → <u>believed</u> God
_	Gen 22:1-19 Jas 2:21-23	Intending to sacrifice Isaac, trusting God to solve dilemma → <u>believed</u> God (Heb. 11:17)

God gave Abraham "credit" for his faith. It wasn't a one-time "experience of faith" but a lifetime of faithful obedience to what God said.
